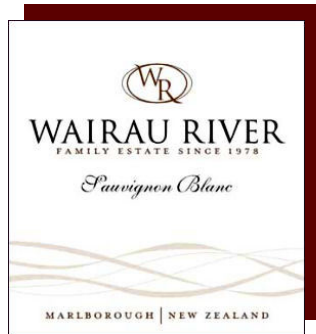

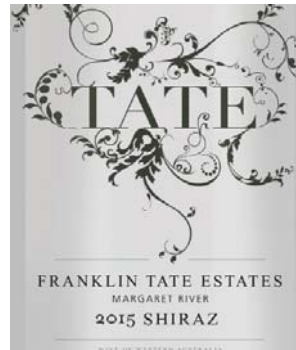


Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc 2017

"This is an elegant wine with intense tropical and stone fruit aromatics with delicate citrus and floral notes, full flavored and textured. The wine has fine mouthwatering mineral acidity on the finish that refreshes the palate, leaving you longing for more."

Baby Iceberg

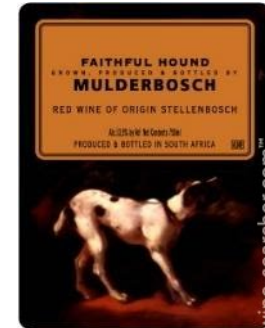


Franklin Tate Shiraz 2015
Appellation: Margaret River
Varietal: 100% Shiraz
Aged: French & American Oak

"This is a highly expressive wine with great fruit concentration driven by mixed berries and dark, juicy cherry fruit. The tannin structure is chewy, and the oak has provided a sweet, chocolatey flavor along with hints of hazelnuts and toast. White pepper lingers on the finish."

Mulderbosch Faithful Hound 2014
Appellation: Western Cape
Varietals: Cab Franc 32%, Cabernet 26%,
Merlot 19%, Malbec 16%, Petit Verdot 7%
Aging: French Oak

"Beautifully rich in appearance, showing a deep, dark core. Seductive aromas of ripe cherries, tobacco leaf, tilled earth and that classic cedar wood fragrance so often associated with Bordeaux-style blends."
