Appellation: Jumilla, Spain  
Varietal: Monastrell  
Aged: French Oak

"Deep purple/black color. Explosive aromas of ripe currant, red berries and smoked notes. Rich, powerful and voluminous on the attack, a huge mouthful of crème-de-cassis concentration, silken and juicy in the mid-palate with excellent length and persistence. Fine, ripe tannins, at once supple and structurally present."

**Rioja Bordón Reserva 2011**  
Appellation: Rioja, Spain  
Varietals: Tempranillo, Garnacha Tinta, Mazuelo  
Aging: 18 Months in French Oak

"Of an intense ruby color with deep brick-colored iridescences. In the nose it is intense and rich in resinous and spicy tones, On the palate it is smooth and velvety, It is full flavored and broad, Very elegant retro nasal taste."
